

Sharonda Singleton was 45 years old. She was born on September 24, 1969 in New Jersey and she died on June 17, 2015 in South Carolina. She was one of the eight people that died on June 17. She died during a Bible study at the Emanuel African Methodist Episcopal Church. She has a 20-year-old son who is a junior at Charleston Southern University and an outfielder on the school's baseball team. "It's a tremendous honor for her," added Singleton, who plans to attend the street-naming ceremony. "I'm going to be overwhelmed with a lot of emotion."
