Rachael Elizabeth Hill grew up in Glen Allen Virginia. Hill had a very close bond with her family. She enjoyed playing the piano, volleyball, and reading scriptures from the Bible. Rachael was a 2006 graduate of Grove Avenue Christian School which was located in Henrico County. She was a freshman studying biology on the Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University campus. Hill wanted to earn a Ph.D. in biochemistry and wanted to specialize in nanotechnology. On April 16, 2007, when Rachael was only 18 she and 31 others were shot and killed in the University in the West Ambler Johnson Hall and Norris Hall.
